Free Prize Draw Terms & Conditions

1. Promoter

The promoter of this free prize draw is **Curo Resourcing Ltd**, registered in **England & Wales**, with a registered office at **Green Acres Manor, Llanboidy, Whitland, Carmarthenshire, SA34 0EE** ("Promoter").

2. Eligibility

- 2.1. The prize draw is free to enter, and no purchase is necessary.
- 2.2. The prize draw is open to individuals aged 18 years or over who are resident in the United Kingdom.
- 2.3. Employees of the Promoter, their immediate family members, and anyone professionally connected with the prize draw are not eligible to enter.
- 2.4. The Promoter may require proof of eligibility (including age and UK residency). If a winner cannot provide proof when requested, the Promoter may withdraw the prize and select an alternative winner.

3. How to Enter

- 3.1. To enter, attendees must scan the QR code available at the Promoter's exhibition stand at Tech Show London and complete the entry form during the Entry Period.
- 3.2. The prize draw opens at 9:00am on 04/03/2026 and closes at 17:00pm 05/03/2026 (UK time) ("Entry Period"). Entries submitted outside the Entry Period will not be valid.
- 3.3. Entrants must provide the following information:
 - Full name
 - Job title
 - Email address
- 3.4. Providing a phone number is optional.
- 3.5. Limit of one entry per person. Duplicate entries (including entries made using multiple email addresses) may be disqualified.
- 3.6. The Promoter is not responsible for entries that are incomplete, corrupted, delayed, misdirected, or not received due to technical issues, connectivity, device errors, QR code issues, or any other reason outside the Promoter's reasonable control.
- 3.7. By submitting an entry, entrants confirm that they have read and agree to these Terms and Conditions.

4. Prize

- 4.1. The prize is one 1 LEGO set selected by the Promoter. The prize will be up to a maximum value of £120.00 (based on the UK RRP at the time of purchase).
- 4.2. The prize is non-transferable, non-exchangeable, and no cash alternative is available.
- 4.3. If the stated prize is unavailable for reasons beyond the Promoter's control, the Promoter reserves the right to substitute it with a prize of equal or greater value.
- 4.4. Delivery of the prize within the UK will be covered by the Promoter at no cost to the winner. The Promoter will aim to deliver the prize within **28 days** of receiving the winner's confirmed delivery details.
- 4.5. LEGO is a trademark of the LEGO Group, which does not sponsor, authorise, or endorse this promotion.

5. Winner Selection

- 5.1. One winner will be selected at random from all valid entries received during the Entry Period.
- 5.2. The draw will take place on [DRAW DATE] (or, at the latest, within 7 days of the event closing), conducted electronically.

6. Winner Notification

- 6.1. The winner will be contacted using the email address (and phone number, if provided) submitted at entry.
- 6.2. The Promoter will make reasonable attempts to contact the winner. It is the entrant's responsibility to ensure their contact details are accurate.

7. Non-Response & Re-Draw

- 7.1. If the selected winner does not respond within 30 days of the Promoter's initial contact attempt, or if the winner cannot be contacted, is found to be ineligible, or fails verification, the Promoter reserves the right to:
 - disqualify the original winner, and
 - select an alternative winner at random from the remaining eligible entries.

8. Winner Details and Transparency

- 8.1. To demonstrate that a valid award took place, the winner's surname and county (or, if relevant, business name and county) will be made available on request for 30 days after the draw date by emailing sarah.wighton@curoservices.com.

9. Data Protection & Privacy

- 9.1. The Promoter will process personal data for the purposes of administering the prize draw, contacting the winner, and arranging prize delivery.

- 9.2. Personal data collected may include name, job title, email address, and phone number (if provided).
- 9.3. The Promoter will process personal data in accordance with the UK GDPR and the Data Protection Act 2018. The Promoter will only share personal data with third parties where necessary to fulfil the prize (for example, courier services).
- 9.4. The Promoter's lawful basis for processing entry data is legitimate interests (running the prize draw). Where marketing consent is given, the lawful basis is consent.
- 9.5. Entry data will be retained for [X months] after the draw date for administration and audit purposes, then securely deleted, unless the Promoter is required to retain it for longer for legal or regulatory reasons.

10. Marketing Consent

- 10.1. Entry into the prize draw does not automatically opt entrants into marketing communications. Marketing will only be sent to entrants who explicitly opt in via the entry form.
- 10.2. Where marketing consent is given, entrants may withdraw consent at any time by using the unsubscribe link in communications or by contacting the Promoter.
- 10.3. If an entrant does not opt in to marketing via the prize draw entry form, the Promoter will not send marketing communications on the basis of that entry. This does not prevent the Promoter from contacting the entrant where the entrant separately provides their details and explicitly opts in by other means during or after the event (for example, where the entrant requests follow-up and provides consent when their exhibition badge is scanned at the Promoter's stand).

11. Publicity

- 11.1. The winner may be invited to allow the Promoter to use their name and job title for promotional purposes related to the prize draw.
- 11.2. The winner is not obliged to participate in any publicity.

12. General

- 12.1. The Promoter reserves the right to cancel, amend, suspend, or withdraw the prize draw where necessary due to circumstances beyond its reasonable control, or where fraud, abuse, or technical failure compromises the proper operation of the prize draw.
- 12.2. The Promoter may refuse entry or disqualify any entrant where it has reasonable grounds to believe there has been a breach of these Terms and Conditions or improper conduct.
- 12.3. The Promoter's decision in all matters relating to the prize draw is final.
- 12.4. These Terms and Conditions shall be governed by the laws of England and Wales, and the courts of England and Wales shall have exclusive jurisdiction.
